We use kennings in our everyday language, such as 'sky-scraper' for a very tall building.

Each line is a simple phrase of either a noun + a noun + a verb.

+ a noun phrase, try adding -er to the second noun, e.g. cheese-eater.

Kennings describe what a person, idea or object is or does.

ta verb phrase, your verb may end in -ing, e.g. milkshake-drinking.
