Teaching input: Today we are going to use addition and subtraction to solve maths sums. Follow the video and have your resources ready.	Teaching input: Today we are going to compare numbers. Watch the presentation exploring how to compare numbers and what new symbols we are going to use.	Teaching input: Numberblocks: addition and subtraction (60 mins)
Activity/Resources: Practise being a hungry caterpillar and subtract at home: you could use food like Miss Kelly did or subtract your toys from your bedroom.	Activity: Using your number line can you help solve the maths problems. Practise writing out the sum and remember your number formation.	Activity: Watch Miss Kelly reveal a maths problem, have a talk with your grown up about what the answer might be. Try and solve the problem with your bus. Then play with your bus to make your own number sums.	Activity: Use the online dice or your own dice to get 2 numbers to compare and use your crocodile symbols.
