
# Reception Optional Home Learning for 15th June-26th June 2020

#### Maths- Number

Bingo! Draw a simple 3 x 3 bingo grid. Ask your child to put one number in each box below 20. Then use a random number generator on your phone or ipad or simply write the numbers on post-it notes and screw them up and put them into a bowl or jar. Pick out one number at a time and see if your child recognises it on their board. When they have crossed all their numbers out they can shout bingo! Once confident with numbers to 20 you could explore numbers to 30 or even to 100!

#### Understanding the World

Ext: draw a picture of you as an animal. Would you have different parts of different animals? Eg fast legs from a cheetah and a long neck from a giraffe and an elephants big ears so you can hear really well!? What would you be called?

### Literacy-Writing

Write an acrostic poem about lockdown. Write the letters I-o-c-k-d-o-w-n down the side of your page. Can you think of a sentence to go with each letter? You might write about things you've been up to at home. We would love for you to share them on Facebook and Tapestry.
