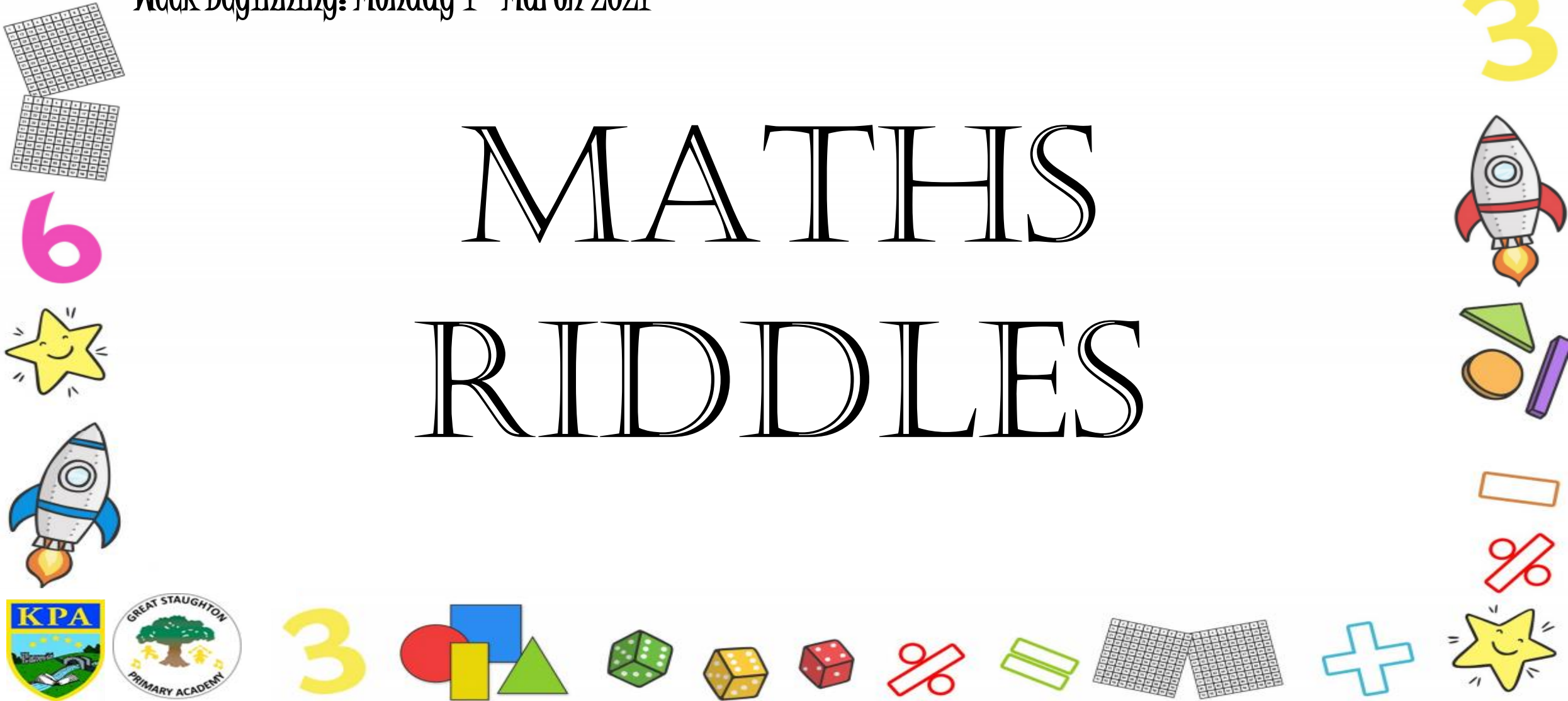
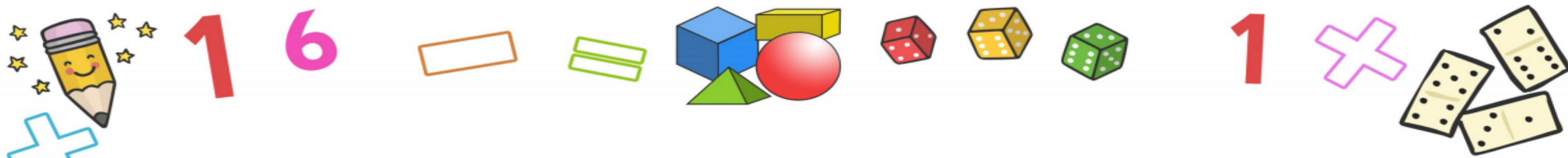

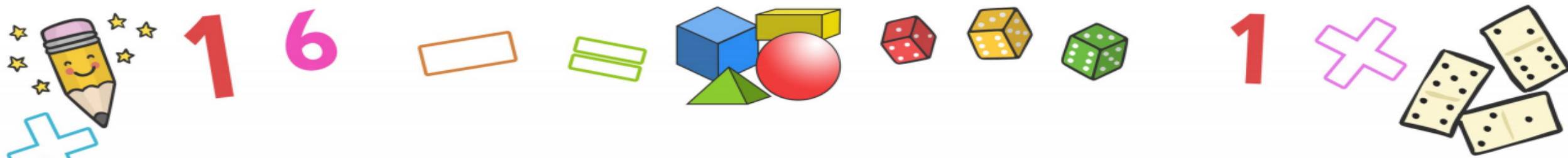

Hint: 150% is the same as the whole amount plus half the amount again.

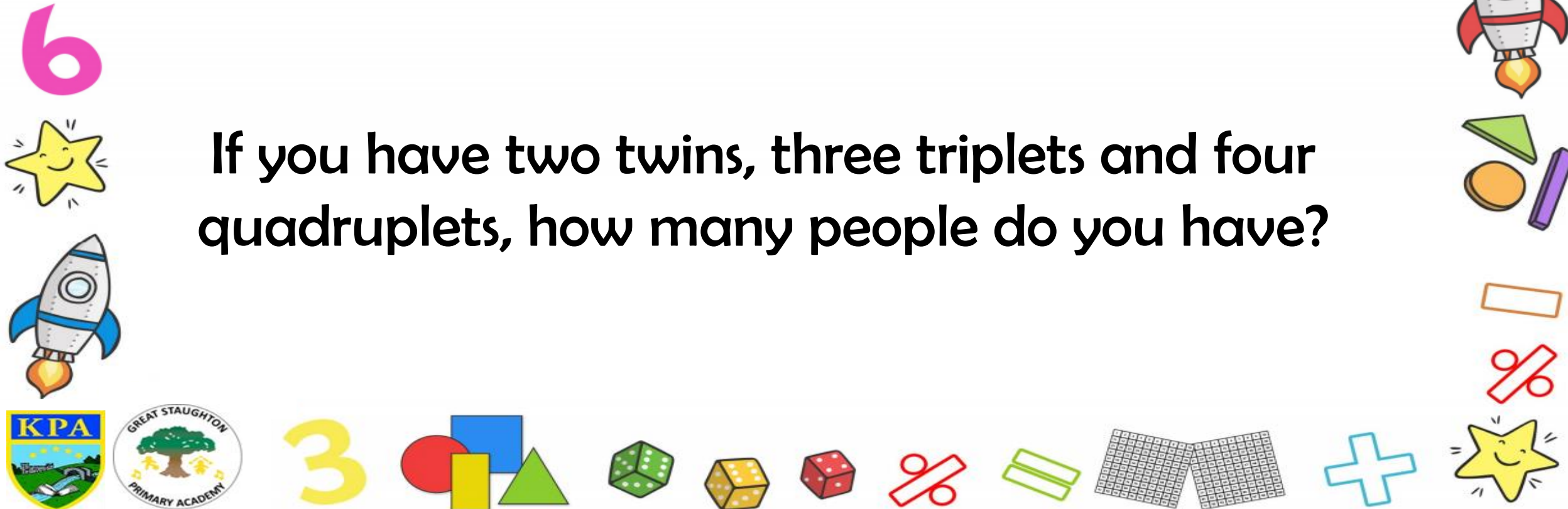


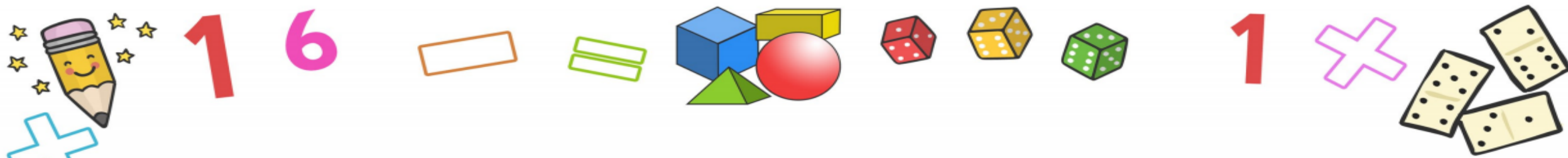

If you have two twins, three triplets and four quadruplets, how many people do you have?

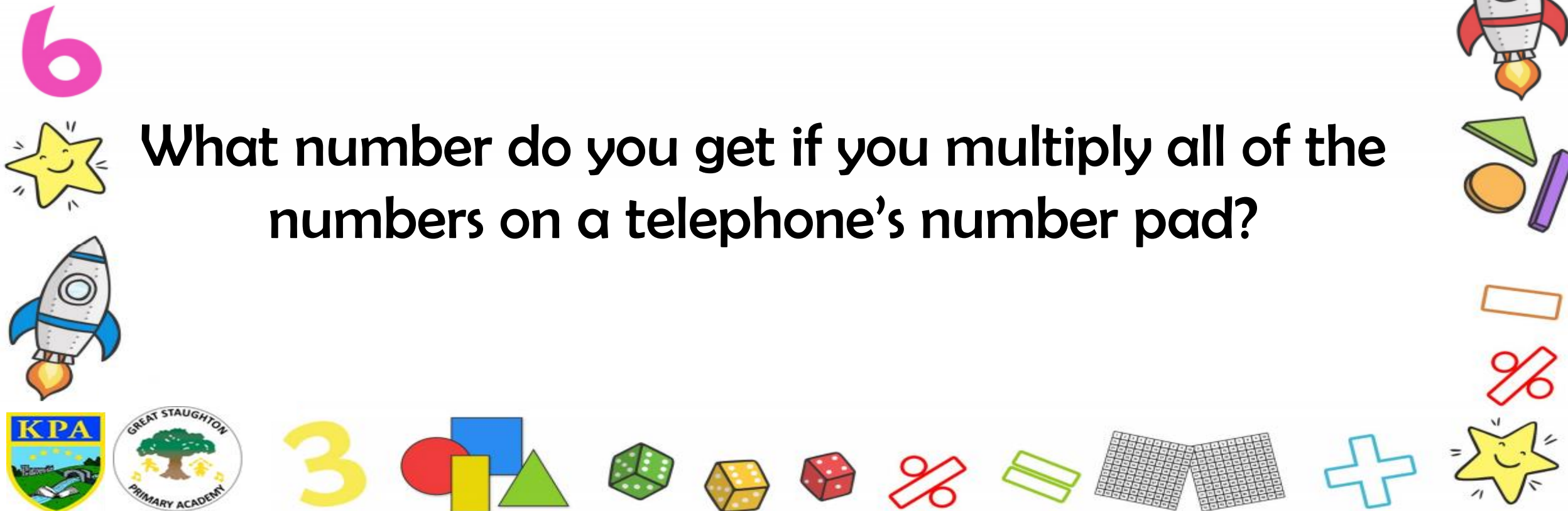


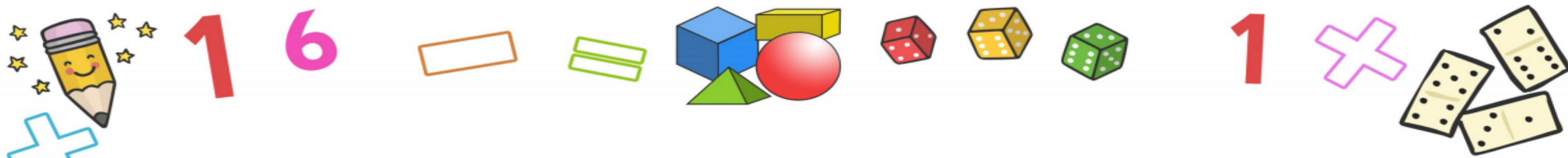

What number do you get if you multiply all of the numbers on a telephone's number pad?

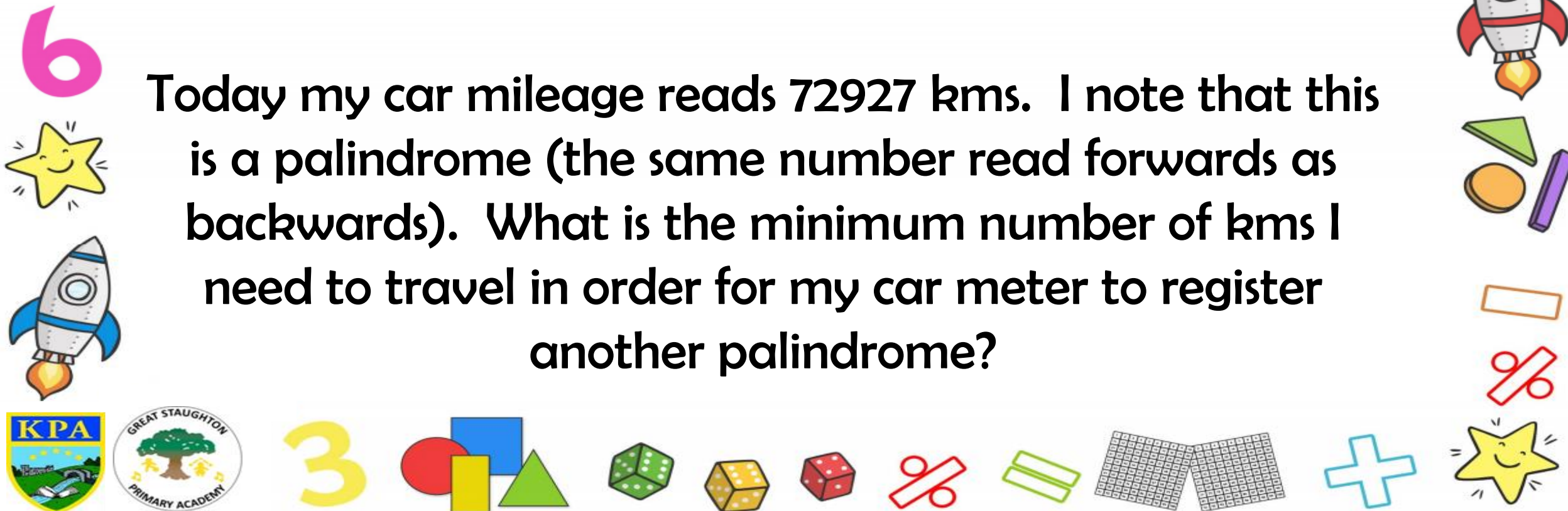


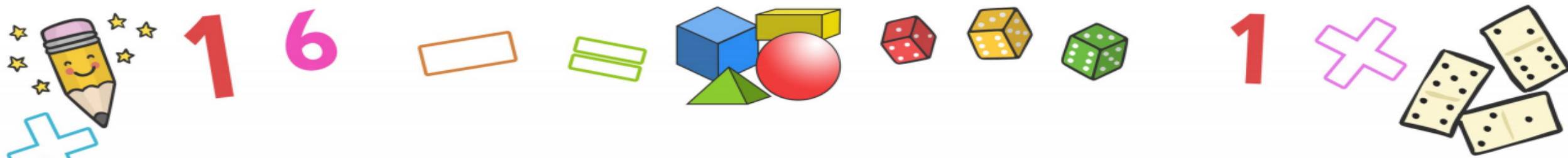
