

Ash/Mars Reception Learning Grid Week Commencing 7th March 2022

This week is assessment week, take time completing the activities to recap our learning.

<u>Activity 1</u> Recognising numbers 0 to 10. Go on a number hunt! What numbers can you see around your house? From your window? You could look at door numbers, food packets, clocks or in magazines and books. You could take photos or draw the numbers you find.	<u>Activity 2</u> Counting and ordering numbers to 20. Collect 20 leaves from your garden or a local park. Write numbers 0-20, one on each leaf using a thick marker pen. Use a hole punch to make a hole in either end of the leaves and then thread them onto a piece of string.	<u>Activity 3</u> Find one more or one less. Ask your grown up to tell you a number. Place this number of raisins or anything to hand on your plate. If your grown up says 'one more' or 'one less' can you count how many is left?
<u>Activity 4</u> Find one more or one less. Park 5 toy cars in a pretend car park. If one car drives away, will there be more or fewer cars? Drive one away and check by counting.	<u>Activity 5</u> You can access Teach your monster number skills through the link below or download the free app on app stores. Then, 2 more people get on. How many people are on the bus altogether? Try drawing a picture to help you work out the answer.
