A quick guide for parents and carers on how to implement Maths-Whizz in your home



Your virtual tutor

Maths-Whizz behaves very much like a human tutor. Once you sign up, the Tutor begins by diagnosing your child's knowledge gaps across several topics with an indepth assessment. The Tutor then automatically creates a learning plan tailored to your child's specific needs based on their 'Maths Age'. With an hour a week, your child can expect to increase their Maths Age by 18 months in the first year!

Find a work space with no distractions.



Constantly aim for at least 3

Getting the most out of Maths-Whizz

- The initial assessment takes around 45 minutes to complete, which your child can complete in multiple sittings. The purpose of the assessment is to give the Tutor an accurate understanding of your child's needs. It is fine to help your child read instructions and navigate between screens but do not answer questions for them the Tutor needs to work out the child's Maths Age, not yours!
- Your child will love Maths-Whizz for the first 3-6
 weeks. You might then notice that their initial
 enthusiasm wears off a little; a weekly schedule will
 help turn learning into a habit (use our weekly
 planner to set your schedule). If they stick with it,
 their confidence will grow and you will see amazing
 improvements within a few months.

- You can sit with your child or leave them to it the Tutor automatically adapts to their needs.
- Aim for at least 3 Progressions a week and use Topic Challenge for extra practice and consolidation. Earn 'Superstar' status on Maths-Whizz by meeting your targets every week and use the PlayZone as a reward.
- Encourage your child to answer every question. If they get stuck, do not give the answer - instead, look at the question together
