

## Year 4 Home Learning for Week Commencing 22nd November 2021



#### Science

LO: I can observe and explain the effects of different voltages on a circuit.

Follow the lesson presentation and complete the activities to learn about high and low pitched sounds.

Activity 1: Collect a variety of objects from your home that might make high or low sounds. This can include musical instruments or other objects. Try to find something that uses strings, percussion and wind to make noise. You should spend some time exploring these, and seeing what is in common between things that make high pitched noises or low noises. Record your ideas on the 'Exploring Pitch' activity sheet.

Activity 2: Pan pipes challenge. Follow the instructions from your lesson presentation to create a set of pan pipes using drinking straws. You should experiment with different notes you can produce by

changing the length of each straw. What do you notice about the link between the pitch of sound made and the length of the straw?

Challenge: Research sounds that are too high or too low for humans to hear. How do animals use these sounds to help them survive?
