

Emperor

Duties:

- Leader of the senate.
To call meetings and decide on the subjects discussed and their outcome.
Listen to advice from the senate.
- Leader of the religious office.
To conduct religious ceremonies and create religious buildings.
- Legal Authority.
To enact and revoke the death penalty.
To have the final say in any laws or decrees to be passed.

Must be:

Decisive, organised, understanding, and with a good knowledge of Roman society. Must also be good speaker.

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Senator

Duties:

To help the Roman state in the following ways:

- To create 'decrees' (rules a bit like laws).
- To decide how state money is spent.
- To meet with other senators in the curia and discuss issues within Rome.

Must be:

Trustworthy, loyal and must have great listening and speaking skills. They must also be wealthy.

Senators will not be paid for this role but will gain a lot of respect.

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Entertainer

Duties:

- To perform to the wealthy and entertain them.
- To create a performance and practise it – this could be as a musician, dancer, actor.

Must be:

Confident, talented and resourceful and with a good understanding of what the Roman people would enjoy.

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Soldier

Duties:

- To follow orders and listen to their centurion.
- To fight for Rome in fierce battle (when necessary).
- To build camp every day (including a ditch and wall of stakes).
- To train for fighting in formation and also in man-to-man combat.

Must be:

Physically fit and strong, disciplined, able to listen to and follow instruction, a team player.

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Merchant

Duties:

- To run a market stall and organise your slaves to help in your shop.
- To keep track of sales, money and stock levels.
- To buy and sell items from around the Empire, including Spain, France and Africa.
- To make money for the Empire and pay your taxes.

Must be:

Organised, with good maths skills and a good communicator. Confident and able to persuade others.

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Farmer

Duties:

- To dig and plough fields to grow wheat for bread.
- To use tools including hoes, rakes and spades.
- To harvest the crops using sickles.

Must be:

Healthy and fit, able to work long hours, have a positive attitude and able to persevere. This was considered a noble and important job in Roman times.

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
