DT

LO: To evaluate our painted divas.

ART

LO: To create a Spring collage using natural materials.

Can you create a collage that shows what 'Spring' means to you. Use natural materials that you might find outside such as grass, flowers, leaves etc.

Once you have completed your collage, can you write a short paragraph explaining your picture and why you have used your chosen materials.

SCIENCE

LO: To recount the life of someone famous from Britain who lived in the past who had an impact on our lives today.

Work through the PowerPoint introducing John McAdam and think about his invention.

How did his invention impact on life today?

Create a fact file on John McAdam and make sure you include interesting facts about his invention.

PSHE

LO: To be able to participate in making and changing rules.

Imagine you are at Greaton School, where children feel safe, and like learning and playing.
Can you design Greaton School, draw and label all the features that make it safe and a good place to learn.

How many people in this school feel and which rights are being met there?

Can you develop a set of ground rules for behaviour to ensure that the feelings and rights at Greaton School can be replicated in our own school?
