He created the angels from light and the jinns from smokeless fire.

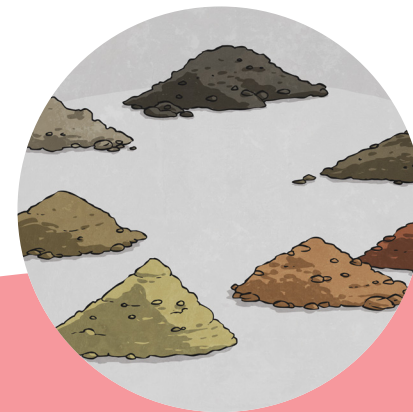
Allah made many things that we can see and hear, as well as other things that we cannot see or hear but we know that they are there, such as the angels and the jinns.

After Allah (Glory be to Him) made the shape of Adam from clay, He breathed life/soul into Adam!

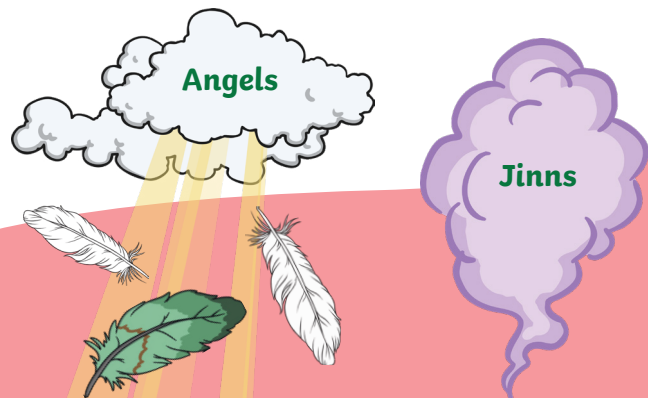


4. Angels and Jinns

Adam and Eve lived happily in paradise and they had everything that they wanted.

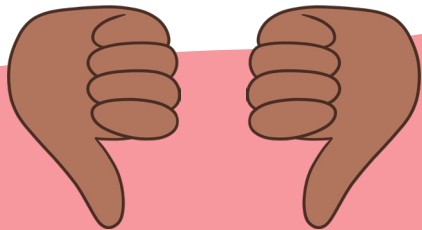


8. An Evil Plan

He decided that his only mission would be to trick Adam and Eve and make them disobey Allah. This is still his plan to this day.

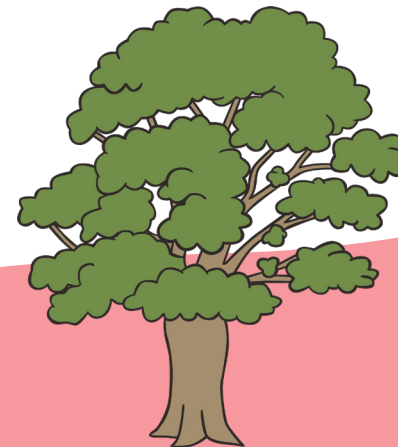
Allah told Adam and Eve to be aware of the Shaytan and not to fall for his tricks.
