


How Rivers Change Shape

A	The river flows more quickly here. It has more energy.
	It wears away the side of the bank, widening and deepening the channel.
	The rivers flows more slowly here.
A	It doesn't have much energy to carry its load.
	The load is deposited, making the channel less deep.
