Conjunction Chains



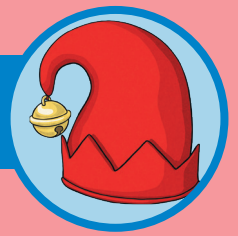
I was so excited **when/because/as/for** I saw my Christmas presents.

As they slept, the Smith family heard banging coming from the fireplace.

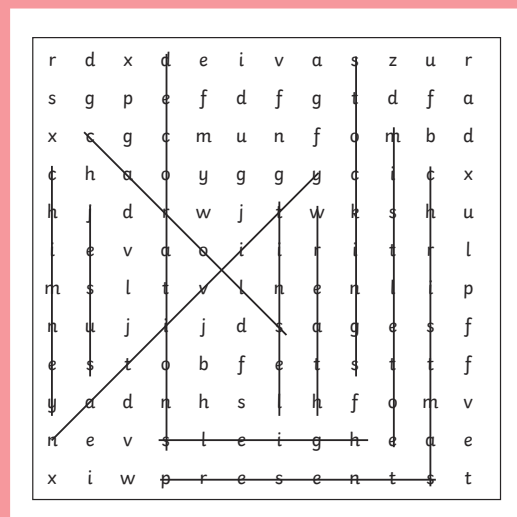
Quickly, they phoned the fire brigade to free him.

Covered in dust, Santa sneezed all of the soot out of his nose.

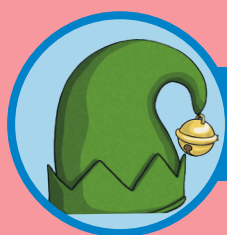
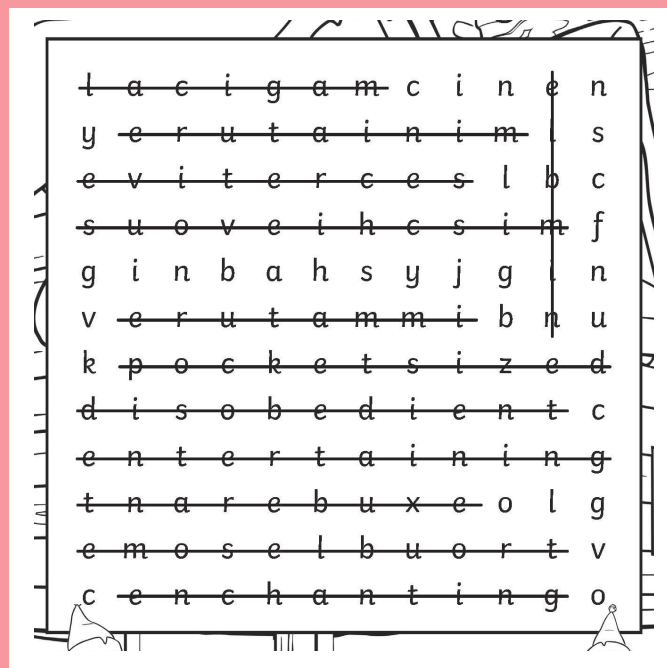
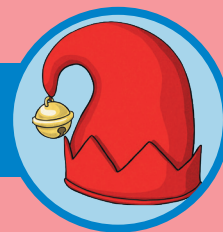
Clearly embarrassed, his cheeks turned a bright shade of red.
