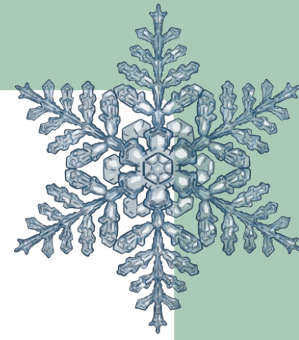

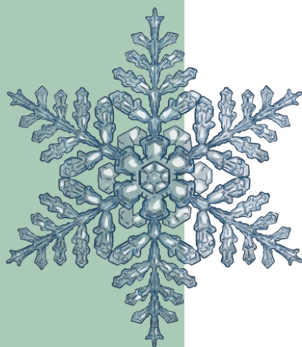

Sentence 1: Include an apostrophe for possession.

Sentence 3: Use a dash or dashes to indicate parenthesis.

Sentence 4: Include a relative clause.

Nan says the cat might end up pulling the electrical wires, which could cause a fire.

Sentence 5: Use a modal verb.

Because of this, she might have to take the tree down early.

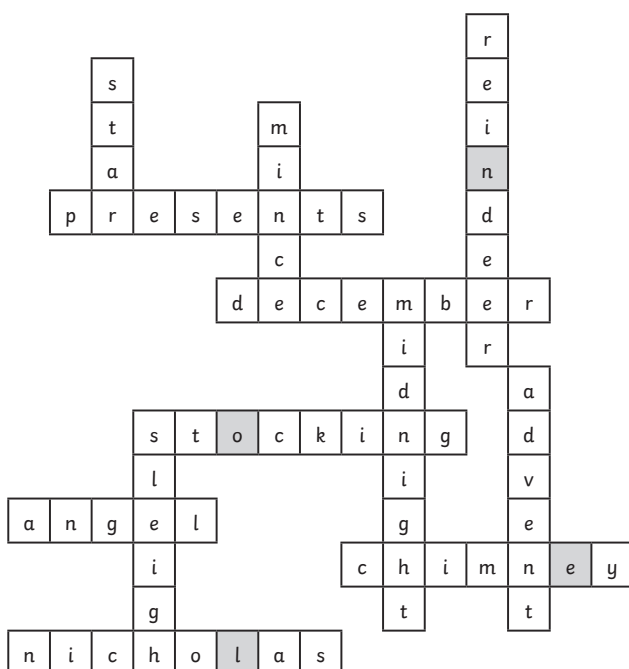
Example sentences:
