

<u>Careers Week</u> This week it is Careers Week. Have a go at some of the activities on the website.	<u>Art</u> LO: To use techniques to create a piece of Easter Art. We are creating a piece of Easter Art that will be displayed in the church. To complete this we are focusing on a few different techniques. Work your way through the PowerPoint to have a go at the activities and look at the examples. 	<u>RE</u> LO: To understand the importance of the crucifixion of Christ at Easter time. Use the PowerPoint to find out more information about the significance of the Easter story for Christians. We are using this to inspire our art work. Can you complete the speech and thought bubbles to show what each character is saying and thinking.
<u>RE</u> LO: To learn about the 5K's of Sikhism and what they represent. Use the PowerPoint to find out more about Sikh symbols, with a focus on the 5K's. First, complete the symbol and explanation matching activity that matches your ability. Then, create a poster to explain the 5 K's and what they represent.	<u>PSHE Session 1</u> LO: To be able to know why dental hygiene is important and how it contributes to a healthy lifestyle. In this session we are focusing on the importance of dental hygiene. Work your way through the PowerPoint. <u>Activity one:</u> Complete the cutting and sticking activity, showing which foods are healthy and unhealthy for your teeth. <u>Activity two:</u> Create a poster showing everything you have learnt, and why dental hygiene is so important.	<u>PSHE Session 2</u> LO: To be able to reflect on your own lifestyles and take responsibility for making healthy choices.
