LO: To identify and name emotions that may be involved in loss and change situations.

In this session we are exploring the different emotions you can feel when experiencing loss or change situations.

Your task is to imagine that a friend is moving to a different country. In a comic strip format, draw four pictures of yourself, with thought bubbles to describe what you are thinking and feeling - one picture represents when you find out it is going to happen, but the friend hasn't yet left, the next is just after the friend has left, the third is three or four weeks after the friend has left, and the fourth is a year later. Think about the emotions you would feel, and how these change in each picture. Can you think of ways to feel better when feeling these emotions.

Science

LO: To identify and name a variety of plants and animals in a range of habitats.

In today's session we are discussing what a habitat is and the different habitats we know.

First work through the PowerPoint.

Then go outside and investigate the local habitats. Using the worksheet, make a list of all the things that are living, dead or have never been alive.

Then after you have explored the habitats, create your own map of the local habitat.

LO: To mix primary colours with accuracy.

LO: To understand the miracles of Jesus and why these were important.
