

<p><b><u>RE Lesson 1</u></b></p> <p><b>LO: To understand the story of The Crying Camel.</b></p> <p>Use the PowerPoint to read through the Islamic story of the Crying Camel. Can you order the story using the sequencing cards and retell it in your own words.</p> <p>Then, answer the questions on the PowerPoint in full sentences.</p>	<p><b><u>RE Lesson 2</u></b></p> <p><b>LO: To understand the message in the story The Boy who Threw Stones at Trees.</b></p> <p>Use the PowerPoint to read through this Islamic story. Choose one of the differentiated activity sheets to complete about caring for the environment.</p>	<p><b><u>PSHE</u></b></p> <p><b>LO: To be able to plan and help prepare simple healthy meals.</b></p> <p>In this session we will be discussing healthy meals. Think back to the Eatwell plate, and think about how you can produce a healthy, balanced meal. Imagine you are setting up your own café in your town. You need to plan the menu. You need to make sure that the menu contains a good balance of the different food groups. Have a look at the Children's Food Trust standards summarised on Food Standards and talk about what each standard would mean for your café.</p>
