## **PSHE**

LO: To identify and name emotions that may be involved in loss and change situations.

In this session we are exploring the different emotions you can feel when experiencing loss or change situations.

Your task is to imagine that a friend is moving to a different country. In a comic strip format, draw four pictures of yourself, with thought bubbles to describe what you are thinking and feeling - one picture represents when you find out it is going to happen, but the friend hasn't yet left, the next is just after the friend has left, the third is three or four weeks after the friend has left, and the fourth is a year later. Think about the emotions you would feel, and how these change in each picture. Can you think of ways to feel better when feeling these emotions.

#### Science

LO: To identify that light is reflected from a surface.

In todays session we are discussing reflection, what it is and what materials could be used.

Then you have been asked to help design a new book bag with a reflective strip. You need to find the most reflective material for the bag. You should make a prediction and record it on their Testing Reflective Materials Activity Sheet.

Then using the instructions in the PowerPoint, create your reflection tester, test different materials.

## RE

LO: To understand the miracles of Jesus and why these were important.

Work through the PowerPoint to find out more about the miracles of Jesus. In this lesson, we are focusing on the miracle of Jesus healing a blind man. Once you have read over the story, choose the differentiated sheet that matches your understanding and sequence the events. Finally, use the lined paper to answer the question 'Why were the miracles of Jesus important?'

LO: To mix primary colours with accuracy.
