Input:

Explore and read the book
Beegu. Discuss the events in
the story. Can the children
make predictions about what
is going to happen next? Can
they talk about the main
events? The main
characters? Discuss the
characters and events while
reading/ listening to the
story. Pause for discussions.

Task: draw Beegu. Can you think of some words to describe Beegu? Use your phonics to record your ideas.

Reread/ listen to the story
Beegu. and talk about how
Beegu is feeling at different
points in the story. Why
might Beegu be feeling like
that?

Task:

Explore different facial expressions for different emotions. Use mirrors if possible. (happy, sad, scared, worried, excited etc).

Input: recap phonics sounds taught so far using your phonics pack. Lay out the cards to spell the word hat. Ask your child to change one sound to make the word 'pat'. Then to change it to 'gat', then to 'gap'. Discuss which sound changes each time.

Task: Complete the CVC word challenge. Encourage your child to say and listen to the sounds in the words using the images and to record each sound in order. Ensure your child says the words, not you, unless they are struggling.

Input: sing incy wincy spider and warm your fingers up by using your hands to make a 'spider' walk up a drainpipe.

Task: Complete the letter formation worksheets. Practise any letters that are particularly tricky. Challenge: can you make your letters sit on a line? Use lined paper or draw some wide lines on plain paper. Practise sitting your letters correctly on a line. Remember, f, g, j, p, q, y all have descenders which sit under the line.
