<p>Look at the image of polar bears. Discuss what you can see, where you think they are going and how you think they are feeling.</p> <p>Read the story starter. Discuss what you think is going to happen next.</p> <p>Draw a picture of what you think happens next.</p> <p>Challenge: Record some words, phrases or a sentence to explain what is happening in your picture. Use your phonics sounds to help you.</p>	<p>Look at the image of polar bears on the PowerPoint slides.</p> <p>Discuss what you can see in the photograph.</p> <p>Discuss the questions on the PowerPoint Slides.</p> <p>Adult to scribe what child says and record on Tapestry.</p>	<p>Use the rhyming cards to play a rhyming pairs game.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Lay the cards out and match all the rhyming pairs.2) Or turn them all face down and take turns to turn over 2 cards. If they rhyme you can keep them. This might work best with a smaller selection of cards.	<p>Choose 5 words from word wall 1 to practise spelling.</p> <p>Use the look, cover, write template to practise spelling the words.</p>	<p>Use your phonics pack to recap all the phonics sounds taught so far.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Play a game of splat! Lay the cards out and take turns to splat a sound with a fly swat or spatula.2) Hide and seek- hide the sounds around your home. Ask your child to find them and tell you the sound. <p>Use the phonics cards to make words. Eg say a word and child has to make the word.</p>
