Pretend to be a tiger and see how far you can jump. Mark each time how far you jumped.

Which jump was the shortest?

Which jump was the longest jump?

Where do you need to start from to make it fair each time?

Brick lengths

Using lego or duplo. Put the brick in size order.

Smallest first and longest last.

Which is the longest brick? How can you tell?

Which is the shortest brick?

This brick is 6 spots long?

Sandcastles

Using sand or play dough make castles moulding them by hand.

Now discuss with an adult which is the tallest castle and which is the shortest.

Which is the shortest castle?

Can you make a shorter castle?

At the vets

Can you role play as a vet? Make sure you look after all the poorly animals!

You can pretend that your teddys are the animals.

Now you have all the animals in the vets, can you compare which is the tallest animal? And which is the smallest animal?

Build a town

Make a town of different building heights. With a grown up compare their heights, you can even compare by how many bricks each building has!
