

## Reception Maths Grid Commencing 5<sup>th</sup> July 2021

In a shop, Teddy buys 5 cakes and 5 apples.  
How many things does he buy altogether?

Draw some pictures to help you work out the answer.



Cover your eyes and listen carefully.  
Your grown up will slowly drop some coins into a money box.

Each time you hear the coins drop count them in your head.

How many did they drop?

Have a look at the powerpoint revealing different coins.

Talk to a grown up, what shape are they? What colour? Shout the value of the coin.

(Remember p means pence!)

Have a go at colouring each coin on the worksheet the correct colour.

How much money is in my jar?

Count the pennies in each jar and write the correct amount below in the box.

Remember to add p for pence at the end. E.g. 7p

Toy Shop

With your toys make your own toy shop. Add labels to your toys so customers know how much it will cost.

Challenge: Can you count out the correct coins to buy the toys?
