Could: Evaluate their piece of work.

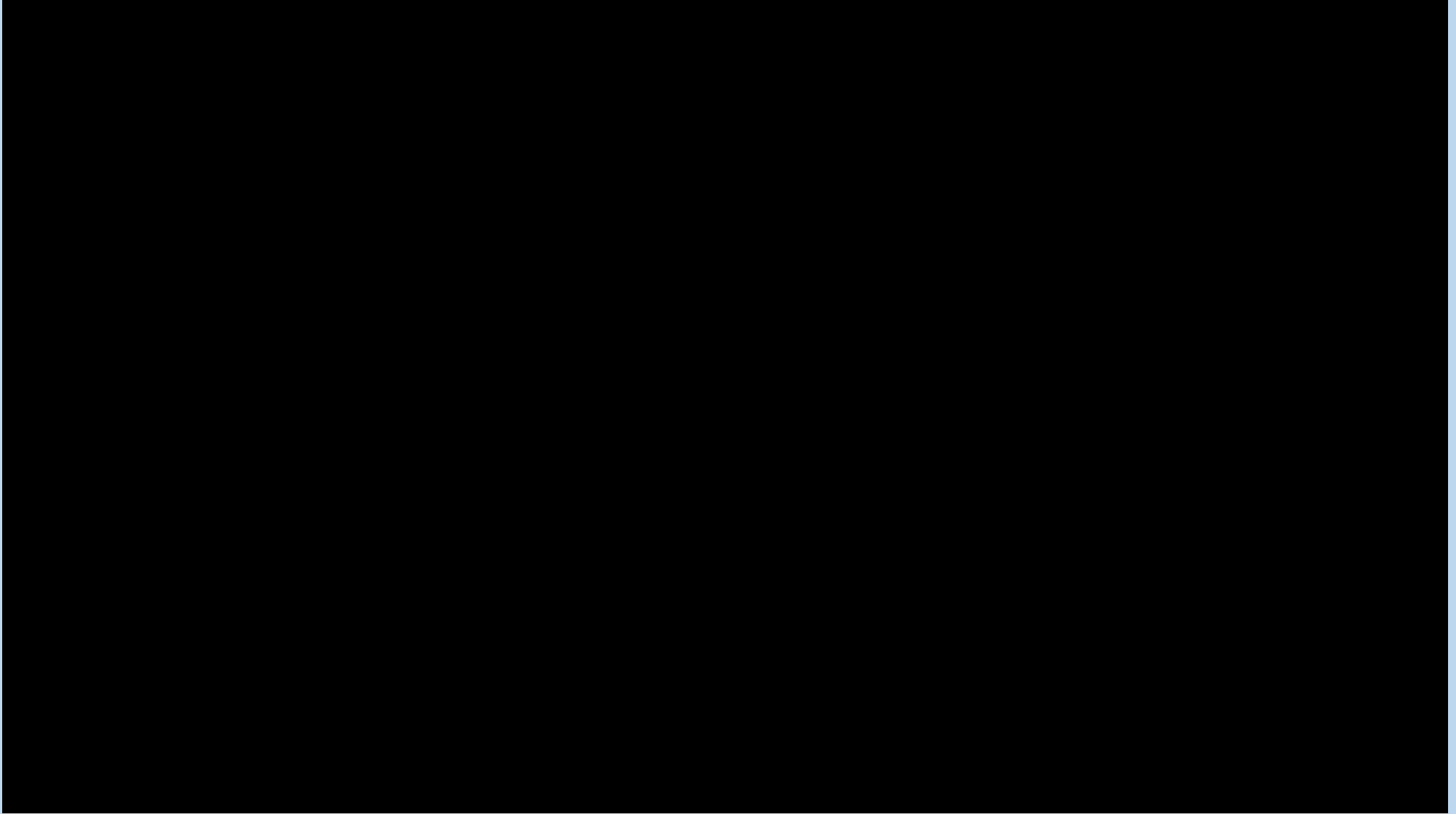


During lockdown
