Day 1 Session 1: Think back to your previous work on dragon sketching. Use your dragon-drawing skills to create a simple dragon shape that could form part of your dragon bowl design.



Consider what type of dragon and what features you would like to include in your sculpture. Annotate your sketch to explain your design choices and modifications. **Keep your sketches safe as you will need it when you come back to school.**

Day 1 Session 2-3: In our D & T creative days this week, we will be designing and making our dragon inspired bowls. Look at the images of previous creations and some from ideas from the internet. **Your task:** is to design a bowl (or small tray) to hold small items (sweets, jewellery, cufflinks, small change) for someone you know. Using the images as inspiration – design your bowl. Explain who your bowl is for and how that has influenced your artistic choices.



Day 2 Design and make a board game

This term's topic is going to be 'Travelling through Space and Time'. Use your knowledge and research on the universe and different periods in history to create an entertaining and informative game to keep 2-4 players occupied during lockdown. You may wish to base your game on one you know well or you may wish to invent something original.

Keep notes of your research and board game design and plans. Once you have researched your possible destinations, in space and different periods in history, create your board game using any materials that you can find at home.



Play your game. Consider what you could do to improve it.

RE Day 1 – Buddhism

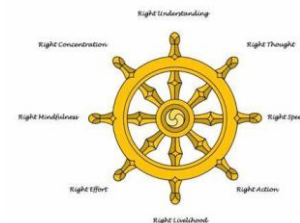
RE – Buddhism Session 1
