- Introduction What is the argument / discussion about?
- Arguments FOR (in favour) with information to support.
- Arguments AGAINST with information to support.
- Recommendation Final paragraph – summary and final decision.

Word/Sentence Level Features

- Use present tense eg This discussion is about...
- Use general terms (use you, they, we) then specific (eg Hunters agree..., Mr Smith, who has hunted for many years...)
- Connect sentences with words like therefore, however, in addition etc.

Discussion

Making the Text Interesting

- Turn the title into a question eg Should we hunt whales?
- Introduce the reader to the discussion. Say why you are debating the issue.
- Use reasons and evidence to support the argument.
- Try to see the argument from both sides and make sure you've been fair to both sides.
- In the final paragraph you must give a reason for what you decide.
