Exciting Writing	<p>LO: to sequence words alphabetically.</p> <p><b>Must:</b> recite the alphabet.</p> <p><b>Should:</b> sequence letters in the alphabet.</p> <p><b>Could:</b> sequence words alphabetically.</p>	<p>LO: to write a contents and title page.</p> <p><b>Must:</b> write a catchy title.</p> <p><b>Should:</b> select content for your information book.</p> <p><b>Could:</b> sequence the content for your information book.</p>	<p>LO: to write an introduction.</p> <p><b>Must:</b> punctuate sentences correctly.</p> <p><b>Should:</b> sequence sentences logically.</p> <p><b>Could:</b> explain the purpose of an introduction</p>
<p><b>Input:</b> Discuss the 5 senses and look at the firework picture on the task sheet. If you were there, what would you see? Hear? Smell? Taste?</p> <p><b>Task:</b> Write about what you can hear, see, taste and smell linking to the picture of fireworks.</p> <p><b>Challenge:</b> think carefully about the descriptive words you will use.</p>	<p><b>Input:</b> Explain that today we are going to be using our knowledge of the alphabet to create a simple glossary for our information books. We know that a glossary has words in alphabetical order, so they are easier to find.</p> <p>Work through the PowerPoint, sequencing words in alphabetical order.</p> <p><b>Task:</b> choosing your own level of challenge order the words in alphabetical challenge and match with the correct definition. Stick this on the glossary page of the non-fiction book template.</p>	<p><b>Input:</b> Explain that today we are going to decide on a title for our information books. We are creating them about the great fire of London so we need to think carefully about the title, so people know what the book is about.</p> <p>Work through the PowerPoint and discuss possible title ideas and why they would be good or not.</p> <p>Then talk about a contents page. Recap what a contents page is and look at some examples.</p> <p><b>Task:</b> Write a catchy title on the title page of your booklet. Then complete the contents page.</p> <p>Choose 2 headings that you will write about next week.</p>	<p><b>Input:</b> work through the PowerPoint.</p> <p>Look at and read some introductions from different non-fiction books.</p> <p>What is the purpose of an introduction? What makes a good introduction?</p> <p><b>Task:</b> Write a short introduction about your book. Remember, it will be about The Great Fire of London. Look at the example in the PowerPoint to help you and think about what you will include in your book.</p>
