Input: Have a discussion to recap the features of an instruction text. Look at a recipe book to support this discussion. Then work through the PowerPoint which introduces time connectives. Task: Use the worksheet to practise spotting time connectives! Challenge: Write a list of as many time connectives you can think of. Can you write a sentence using a time connective?	Input: Have a discussion to recap the features of an instruction text. Look at a recipe book to support this discussion. Use the PowerPoint to practise spotting time connectives. Task: Discuss the steps for getting ready for break time. Can you write a sentence using a time connective for each of the pictures? Challenge: Can you add a conjunction eg and/but to extend your sentence?	Input: Have a discussion to recap the features of an instruction text. Look at a recipe book to support this discussion. Discuss and make your own jam sandwich. Discuss and record any key words, time connectives and bossy verbs! Task: Write a set of instructions for making a jam sandwich. Read your writing back to check you have included the features of instruction writing. Challenge: edit and improve your work.	Input: Have a discussion to recap the features of an instruction text. Look at a recipe book to support this discussion. Task: Look at the instructions you wrote yesterday about how to make a jam sandwich. Can someone else at home follow your instructions to make a jam sandwich? Circle the bossy verbs in red and the time connectives in blue.	Task: complete the SPAG mat independently. An adult can help with reading the instructions. Then with an adult mark your SPAG mat and discuss any questions you got wrong. Challenge: Write a set of instructions independently for something of your choice. Eg getting ready for school, making a cake, getting ready for bed.
