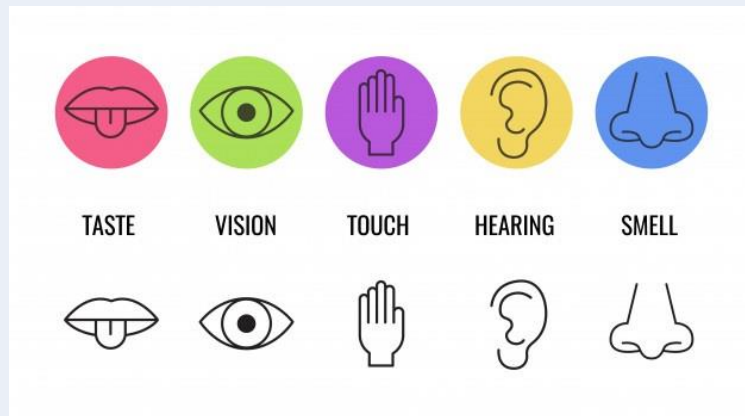


Can you write a descriptive sentence?
