SECURE



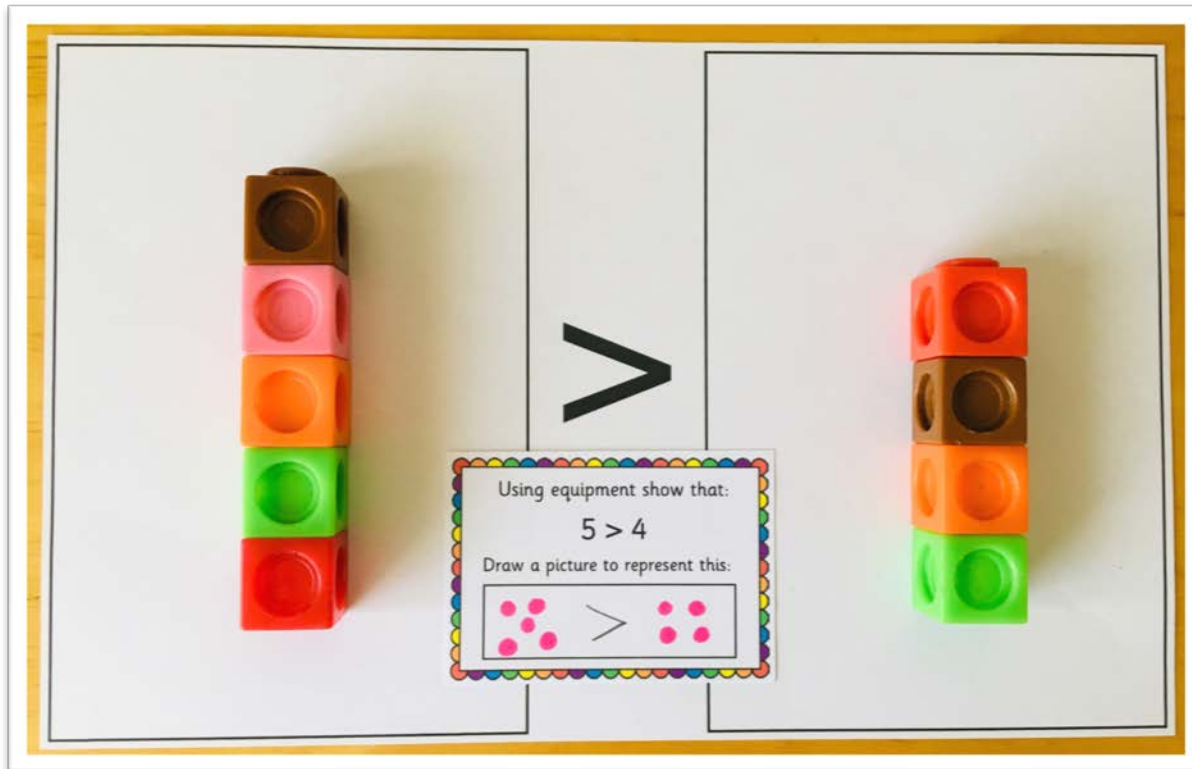
Children will work individually to build and compare the amounts.

They will then draw a picture representation of each comparison.

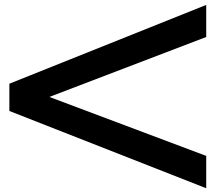

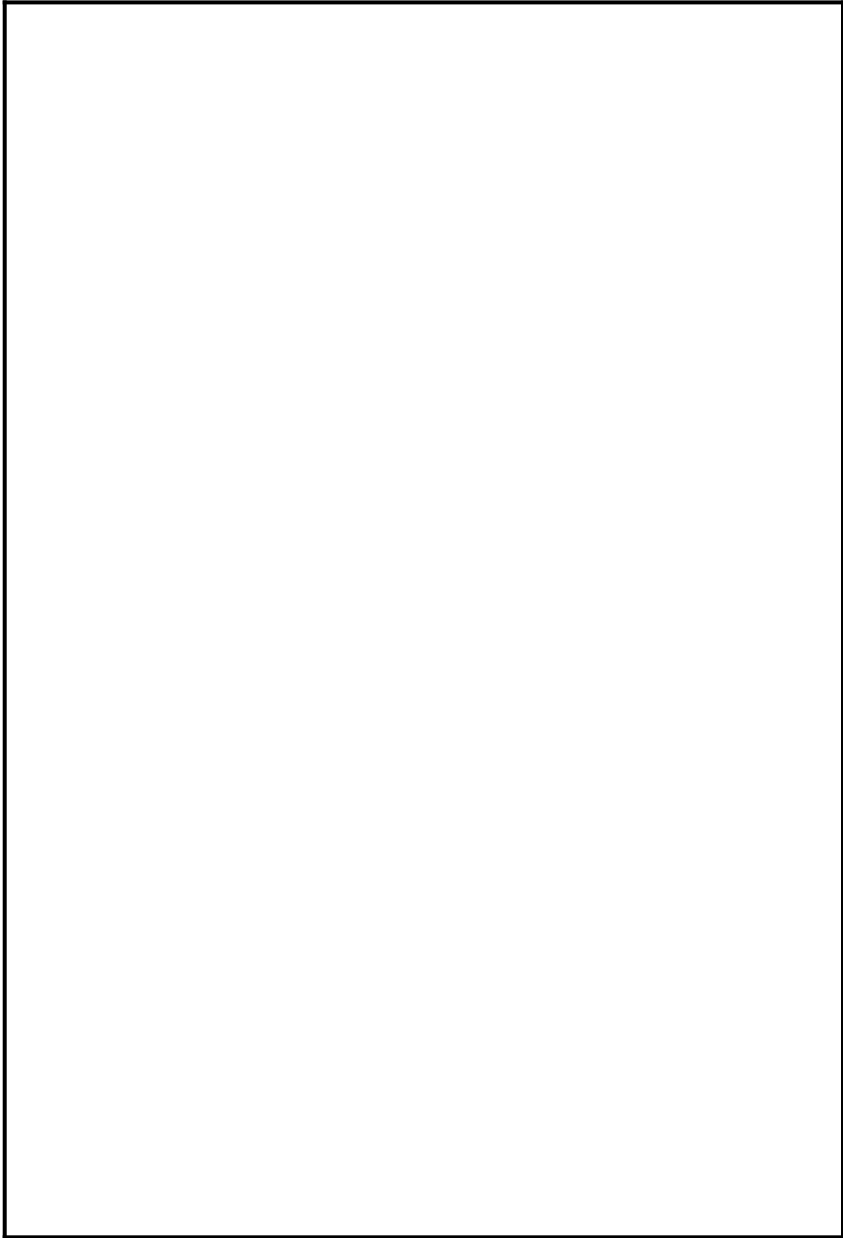

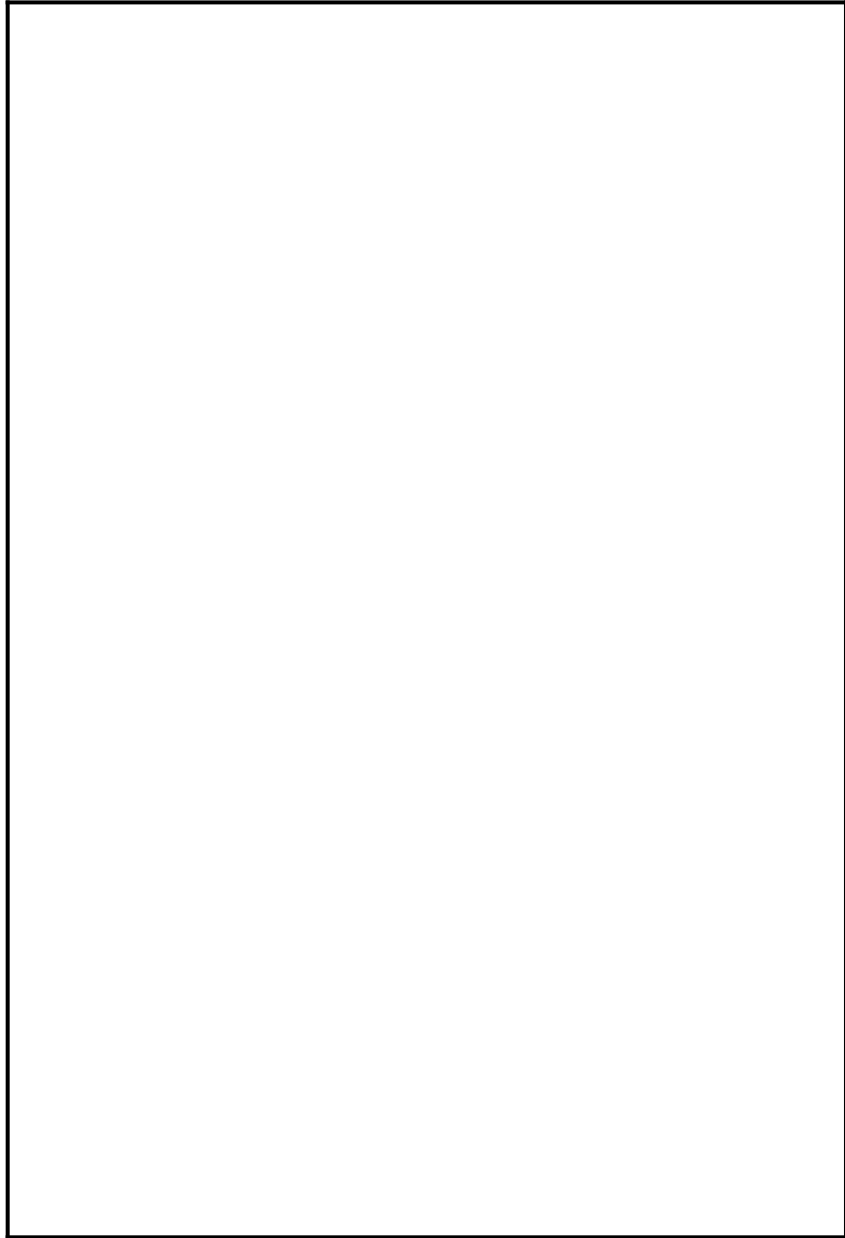
