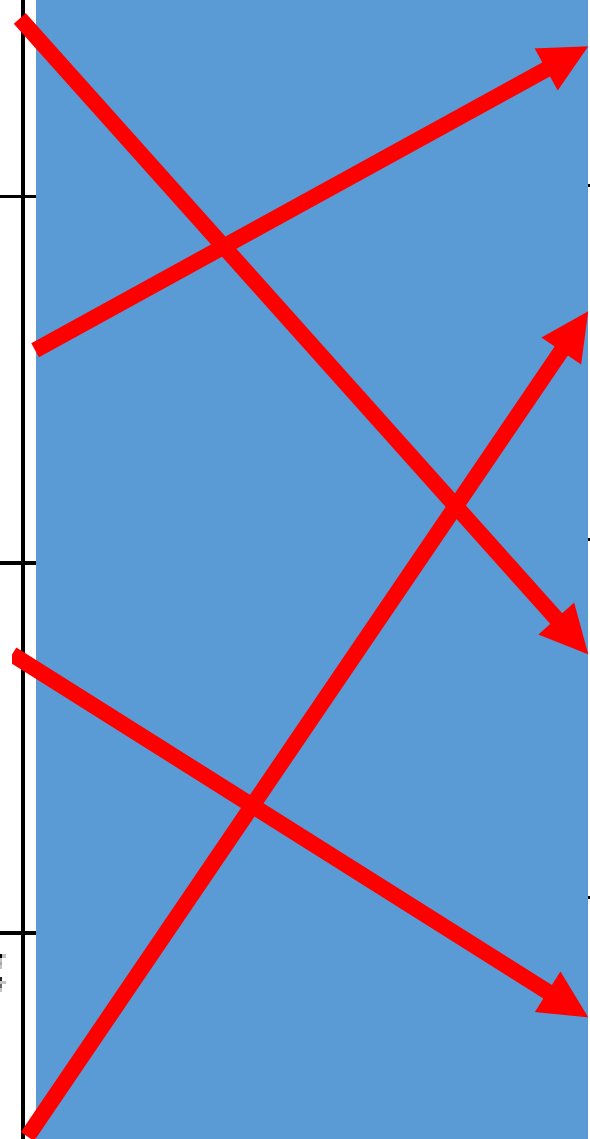
Headlines are:
