A noun is as person, place or thing.

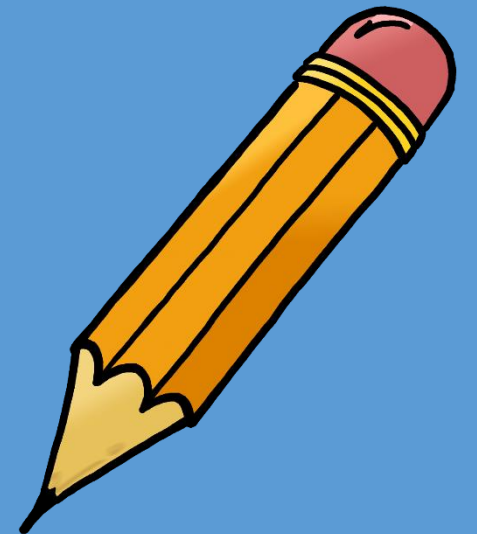

a verb too!

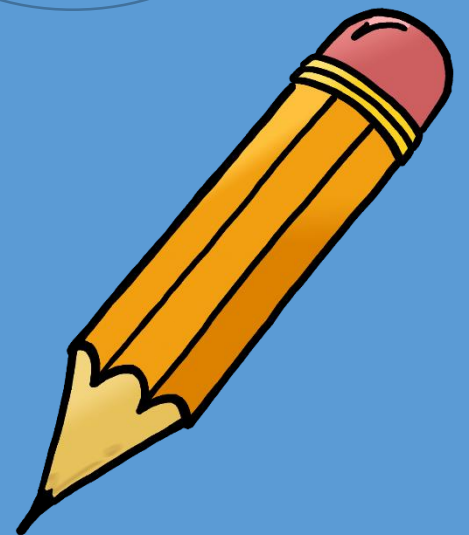

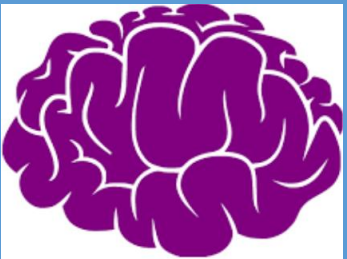
