What do they think is making that sound? Is the sound loud/ quiet? Year 1: Write down some sounds you can hear and what you think is making the sound on the sound walk recording sheet.	Activity: Reception/ year 1: read the poem to your child. Can they hear the rhyming words? Support your child to match the rhyming words. Year 1: Look at the poem on the activity sheet. Can you circle all the rhyming pairs? You could use a different colour for each rhyming pair.
