**Could:** Compare 3 groups by size.

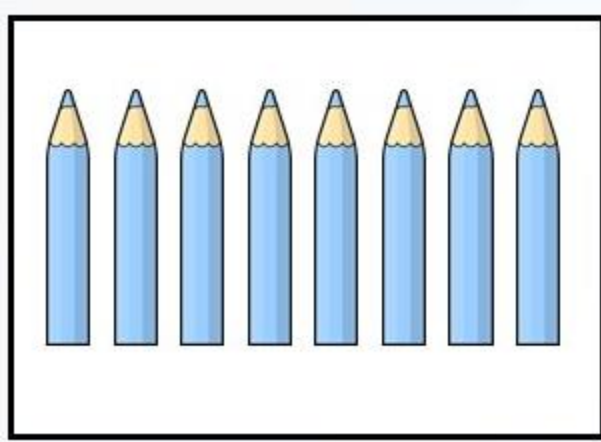
