Year 2 Home Learning for Two Weeks Commencing 1st June 2020

Topic

Use the internet or some books to create a timeline of World History. You must include the Ancient Greeks, the Tudors, the Victorians etc. You could ask an adult to help you order the dates.

RE

Talk to a grown up or sibling about the following philosophy question:

'Can there be happiness if there isn't sadness?'

Computing

Think about all the different ways we can keep safe online.

Create a poster for other children telling them what to do.

PSHE

Think about what makes you an amazing person. You could draw yourself and label the amazing things you do, think, how you are thoughtful etc. (There is a worksheet on the website to help you with this if your adult can access it but a drawing will also be fine).

Music

Can you write a song of your own?



You could play an instrument too or maybe just sing the lyrics.

Art

Design and make a game about Ancient Egypt. It could be a board game, a question and answer game or even a powerpoint game.

Science

Think about some of the objects you were classifying last time. Which materials can be squashed, bent, twisted or stretched to make them change shape? Which can't? How does that relate to the objects which are made from each material?



Bonus activity: Can you draw and write a kindness postcard to someone and post it to them on your daily walk? You could send it to someone you know in the post or pop it through someone's letter box.
