## Extra

Look at what happens when we need to add endings to very short words:  
If the letter **before** the last letter is a **vowel** (a e i o u) – **double the last letter**.

hop + ing = hopping

If the letter **before** the last letter is **any other letter** – **don't double the last letter**.

jump + ing = jumping

## Extension

Remember, if we want to add **ing** to a '**magic**' e word, first we need to take off the **e**, like this:

bake + **ing** = baking

To add **ed** or **er** to a '**magic**' e word, we also need to take off the **e**, like this:

bake + **ed** = baked      bake + **er** = baker
