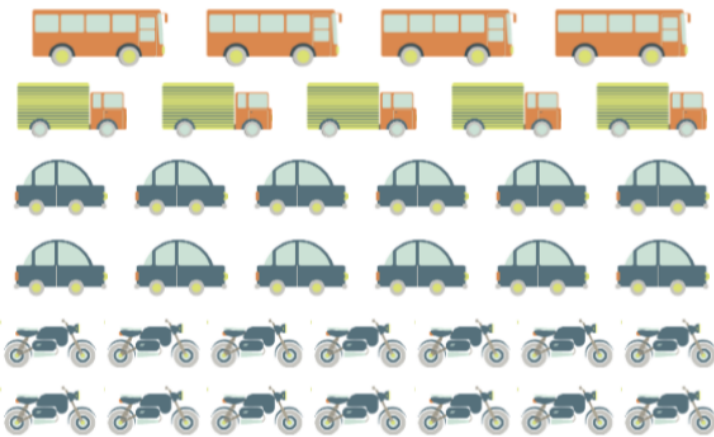


1. Lewis counted the vehicles passing school.

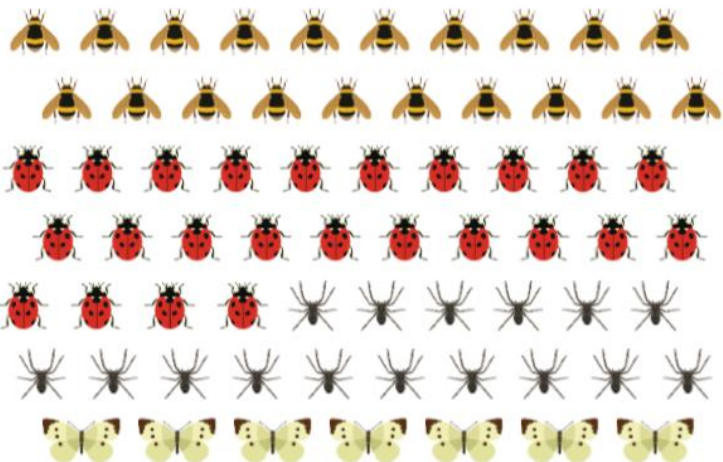
