## **Frequently Asked Questions**

# Does my child need to complete all of the activities?

Parents can choose the activities they think will work best for their child or children, or they can allow pupils to choose which activities they complete and when. It is anticipated that most children will complete most activities during the two weeks.

#### Should I mark my child's work?

You don't need to give formal marking, but it is always helpful to chat and give feedback! You could ask them:

"What went well?"

"How could you make it even better?"

"What would you do differently next time?"

### What if I don't have a laptop or device available for my child?

**PE**: If you cannot access the Espresso link to complete the water safety activities why not discuss this with your child yourself? What do you think is important? Yr3 would have all been swimming with the school and should know lots of ways to stay safe. Perhaps you could ask them to note these down in sentences and pictures.

**Art:** A pdf version of the information from the website can be found on the class page for this week. Although it is a shame to not see the video, the information is all the same so this should help!

**Topic:** Don't worry if you can't access the internet for this, hopefully you can see the Power Point pdf on the school website so you can discuss Ancient Egyptian facts with your child to enable them to create their own fact file.

**Computing:** Talk to your child about how it would have been different in Ancient Egypt for them. Could you write a list together and then ask them to use paper and pencils to illustrate their ideas!

**Bonus Activity:** Everyone knows the story of Cinderella so if you can't listen to the Egyptian Cinderella story, simply ask your child to write their own version. What might happen in the beginning, middle, and end? Where do you think it would be set?
