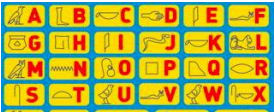


Year 3 Home Learning for Week Commencing 15th June – 26th June 2020

<u>Topic</u> Read about the Egyptian gods here: http://www.primaryhomeworkhelp.co.uk/egypt/gods.htm and using the Twinkl Power Point on the school website. Once you've read up about them, write your own fact file about what the ancient Egyptians believed. 	<u>RE</u> Talk to a grown up or sibling about the following philosophy question: ‘What might God look like?’ Could you draw your ideas? 	<u>Computing</u> Research online what the life of a child would have been like in Ancient Egypt. Can you compare it to your own? Use a computer to prepare a presentation in Word or Power Point, showing your ideas. 
<u>PSHE</u> Can you write down your top 5 worries and discuss them with an adult.  Is there anything you or they can do to help you feel better?	<u>Music</u> Can you write a song of your own? You could play an instrument too or maybe just sing the lyrics.  	<u>PE</u> Complete the following water safety activities on Espresso: https://central.espresso.co.uk/espresso/modules/t1_swimming/index.html?source=search-all-all-all-all&source-keywords=water%20safety 
<u>Art</u> Read about hieroglyphics here: Choose art materials to draw and colour your own hieroglyphics.  	<u>DT</u> Design and make a game about Ancient Egypt. It could be a board game, a question and answer game or even a Power Point game. Ask someone at home to play it with you!  	<u>Science</u> <u>New Topic - Plants!</u> It's important we understand what we mean by 'germination'. Read the Power Point information (<i>found on the school website</i>) and draw and label your own poster explaining this process and what plants need to germinate. 
★ <u>Bonus Activity</u> ★ Listen to the story <i>Egyptian Cinderella</i> here. Get comfortable and listen carefully to the where it is set and the main characters. Think about the beginning, build up, problem, resolution and ending.
