Now design and make a pyramid of your own. You could use Lego, junk modelling, play dough – whatever you have at home!	<u>Science</u>  Plants – Fantastic Flowers! Learn all about the parts of a flower. Read through the PowerPoint found on the class page and use this link. You could also go outside and see if you can find a flower to dissect. Can you find all the different parts and name them? Take a photo and post on the Facebook page for us all to see!
