## Britain is past peak of Covid wave, says Whitty

But chief medical officer warns against relaxing restrictions

The UK has passed the peak of its second coronavirus wave, England's chief medical officer said yesterday, as the number of people vaccinated topped

10 million. But Chris Whitty warned the virus could surge again if restrictions are lifted too soon and that there remains a "residual risk" of future winter waves of Covid-19. "Provided people continue to follow the guidelines, we're on the downward slope of

cases, of hospitalisations and of deaths in all four nations," Prof Whitty said. The health secretary, Matt Hancock, said the inoculation of the 10 millionth person was a "significant milestone", giving the UK one of the highest vaccination rates in the world.
