**Frequently Asked Questions**

**I am not overly happy with my child accessing YouTube without me supervising content.**

**What should I do?**

The clips that are accessible on YouTube have previously been watched and are appropriate for children. As the content is based on natural disasters, you may wish to preview the material first. If you would prefer, the videos can be saved on the school website, so children can access it from there. You will need to contact Mr Nelson for this to happen, as videos will need to be downloaded and then uploaded onto our website.

**Can I complete science this week without using the online resources?**

If you have circuitry resources than great! Use them. Remember, children may need to be supervised to complete this work if using practical resources.

**Frequently Asked Questions**

**Why is the computing task the same as the previous week?**
