### I am not overly happy with my child accessing YouTube without me supervising content. What should I do?

The clips that are accessible on YouTube have previously been watched and are appropriate for children. As the content is based on natural disasters, you may wish to preview the material first. If you would prefer, the videos can be saved on the school website, so children can access it from there. You will need to contact Mr Nelson for this to happen, as videos will need to be downloaded and then uploaded onto our website.

#### DT: What features are expected for the bug hotel?

The finished product should match the design. If this is not possible, make the bug hotel / small creature habitat and comment on changes that needed to be made for the final product. Changing things during the making stage is often needed, the important part is to note changes and comment on reasons for the changes to happen.

#### Bonus activity: How many different answers are there to this problem?

This is a problem solving task. There is often more than one answer to these types of questions. Use a systematic/logical approach and you should get all the different options.

## Year 6 Home Learning for Optional Extra Work 6<sup>th</sup> July 2020 Frequently Asked Questions

#### Why is the computing task the same as the previous week?

There is plenty of content in the stated block of work to last for two weeks. If you wish to progress that is fine. If knowledge isn't secure, take a look at previous years based activities. Work at a pace and level that is suitable for your child.
